Lottie Moon Christmas Offering

You can continue giving toward the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering even though 2018 has ended. You can do so through designating directly to Lottie Moon or through the SBC Mission Offering on your envelope. From the money given to the SBC Mission Offering, 50% is given toward international missions (Lottie Moon), 30% to North American missions (Annie Armstrong), 15% to State missions (Janie Chapman), and 5% to the York Baptist Associations.

The Bible talks about tithes and offerings. I believe 10% of what comes in should go to the local church and then offerings like SBC Missions and World Hunger Offering are given in addition. From what we as a church receive in regular giving, 12% goes to the Southern Baptist Cooperative Program and 3% to the York Baptist Association, along with other monies budgeted for various mission causes.
