Walk as He Walked

“He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked” (1 Jn. 2:6).

The Lord’s Supper

If you have trusted Jesus as your Savior and you are committed to live for Him, you are welcome to participate in the Lord’s Supper this morning. Communion, another name for the Lord’s Supper, symbolizes the death of Jesus Christ on the cross. His body was broken and His blood shed to pay the penalty of sin for you and for me. If we depend on Jesus to save us on the basis of what He did on the cross, we will experience everlasting life and we will be able to walk in newness of life. We are saved by faith in Jesus Christ, but once we are saved God wants us to do good works through the power of Christ (Eph. 2:8-10). He wants us to let our light shine before men by our good works so that God the Father is glorified (Mt. 5:16). The Lord’s Supper gives us an opportunity to remember what Jesus has done for us and re-commit to living our lives for Him by God’s grace.

A portion of scripture that comes to mind as we look ahead to the future is 1 Cor. 9:24-27 (NIV). Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one gets the prize? Run in such a way as to get the prize. Everyone who competes in the games goes into strict training. They do it to get a crown that will not last; but we do it to get a crown that will last forever. Therefore I do not run like a man running aimlessly; I do not fight like a man beating the air. No, I beat my body and make it my slave so that after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified for the prize.
