"He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked" (1 Jn. 2:6).

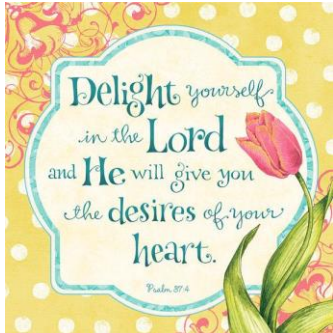
The Lord's Supper

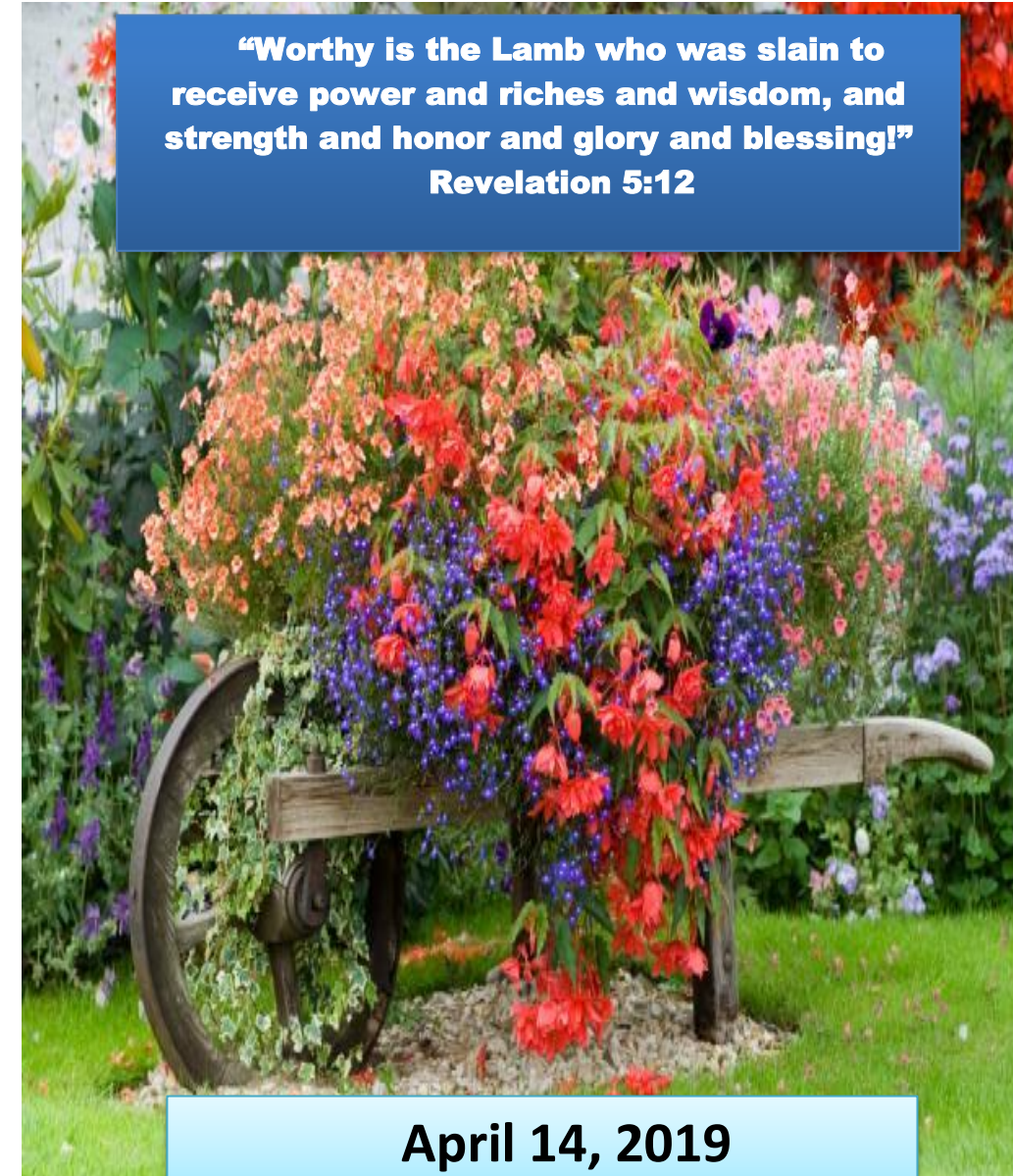
